

Always remember "Moment should be movement to gain momentum"



MEDICAL NEWS UPDATE

Can zero-calorie sweeteners raise your risk for cardiovascular disease?

- A massive study involving French citizens that spanned more than a decade evaluated their use of artificial sweeteners.
- The observational study periodically checked the participants' food and drink intake and had the participants regularly report on their health.
- By the end of the study, the researchers learned that the participants who consumed higher levels of artificial sweeteners experienced cardiovascular disease events at a higher rate than participants who did not consume artificial sweeteners.

While artificial sweeteners may seem like a good alternative to sugar to reduce caloric intake, a study published in The BMJ suggests there may be a connection between such sweeteners and an increased risk for Cardiovascular disease, including stroke.

The research, conducted by the French National Institute for Health and Medical Research, is not the first study to suggest a connection between artificial sweeteners and increased risk for heart disease, however, it is the largest to date. The study included data from more than 100,000 participants. The chosen participants included people 18 years of age and older, as well as people who filled out questionnaires related to diet, health, anthropometric data, lifestyle and sociodemographic data, and physical activity. The average age of the included participants was 42 years, and the majority of the participants were females (79.8%).

Approximately 37% of the participants reported using artificial sweeteners, with the participants divided into non-consumers, lower consumers (artificial sweetener intake below the median), and higher consumers (artificial sweetener intake above the median). The participants consumed an average of 42.46 mg/day.

They consumed the following artificial sweetener types:

- aspartame
- · acesulfame potassium
- sucralose
- cyclamates
- saccharin
- thaumatin
- neohesperidine dihydrochalcone
- · steviol glycosides
- salt of aspartame-acesulfame potassium

3 particularly problematic sweeteners:

According to the authors, "Aspartame intake was associated with increased risk of cerebrovascular events, and acesulfame potassium and sucralose were associated with increased coronary heart disease risk."

Expert speak:

"No calorie artificial sweeteners such as aspartame, saccharin, and sucralose are commonly added to many 'diet' and 'sugar-free' processed foods like pastries, pudding, candy, soft drinks, and more.

Considering that artificial sweeteners are typically found in highly processed foods, I recommend limiting your consumption of them altogether. Some safer alternatives include natural options such as allulose, monk fruit, and stevia which do not seem to carry the same concerns.

Research suggests that heavy use of artificial sweeteners may actually lead to weight gain and obesity, and according to some animal trials, consuming artificial sweeteners may alter the gut microbiota and potentially increase one's risk of certain cancers, although more research is needed to substantiate these claims."

BRCA: The Breast Cancer Gene

Introduction:

Breast cancer is one of the most common types of cancer. About 1 in 8 women (12 %) will be diagnosed with breast cancer during their lifetime. It has a worldwide incidence of 12% In India, it constitutes 30% of all cancers in females. It is the most common cancer type among urban Indian women.

What is BRCA?

Full form: Breast Cancer gene

It is of 2 types: BRCA1- discovered in 1994 and BRCA2 – discovered in 1995. BRCA1 and 2 genes are present in all individuals. They are tumour suppressor genes. They recruit proteins like ATM, CHK2 etc which are DNA repair proteins. BRCA mainly recruits proteins to repair double stranded DNA breaks.

What are BRCA mutations?

These are usually point mutations in the gene sequence. They can also have CNV's (copy number variations) – deletions or duplications. BRCA mutation is a germline mutation, which is why it is hereditary. It is found in both sexes and has an autosomal dominant transmission- The offspring of an individual with a BRCA1 or BRCA2 germline pathogenic variant have a 50% chance of inheriting it.

It is the mutations in the BRCA gene and not the gene itself, that causes carcinomas.

BRCA 1 mutation: is usually associated with high grade triple negative carcinomas. Lung and distant lymph node metastasis are frequently seen.

BRCA 2 mutation: carriers typically develop hormone receptor positive carcinomas. Bone metastases are frequently seen. CNS metastases are more often associated with BRCA2

The presence of BRCA mutations increases the lifetime risk of breast cancer to about 80% and ovarian cancer to ~40%.

BRCA Testing:

Who qualifies?

- · h/o Ca breast at less than 50 years of age
- h/o ovarian cancer at any age
- · h/o family member who is BRCA postive
- · Strong family h/o breast, prostate, ovarian, colon or pancreatic cancer
- · Ca in both breasts
- · Male Ca breast
- · Triple negative breast cancer

Advantages of testing:

Increased screening: screening can be done more often, at a younger age, which leads to early detection and prompt treatment. Preventive medications like tamoxifen / OCP's can be prescribed. Preventive surgeries (oophorectomy/mastectomy) can be planned.

In case of diagnosed breast Ca, BRCA testing before surgery can help to decide how radical the surgery and further treatment needs to be.

In case of a germline mutation in a family, prenatal and preimplantation genetic testing can be offered to avoid further transmission.

BRCA result interpretation:

Negative: the fact that there is no mutation present doesnot rule out a patient's chance is getting breast cancer, or even the possibility of a hereditary cancer syndrome in the family.

Variant of Unknown significance: This shows that there is a defect in the gene but it is not known whether this is associated with cancer risk. It requires further classification into a polymorphism or a mutation.

Positive: It shows that there is a mutation associated with the BRCA genes which shows an increased predisposition to breast, ovarian, prostate, pancreatic and other related cancers

BRCA myths:

- 1. "You don't need testing if you already have had cancer."- The chances of recurrence of breast cancer as well as development of other associated cancers is very high in BRCA positive patients. So testing is highly recommended
- 2. "If the family history is related to the paternal side of the family, hereditary transmission is not possible" This is an autosomal dominant mode of transmission. The father may be a carrier, passing the mutation down to his daughters.
- 3. "I am a man, so I cant get breast cancer" The estimated lifetime risk of breast cancer is 1–5 % in male BRCA1-mutation carriers and 5–10 % in male BRCA2-mutation carriers versus 0.1 % in the general population.
- 4. "I don't want to know because there is nothing I can do" –see Advantages of testing

BRCA mutations in men:

Around one in 260 men (~0.4%) inherits a cancer-predisposing BRCA variant that increases their risk of developing prostate, pancreatic, and breast cancer and may affect the health of their family. Men require to be made aware of the risks as well as screening methods available to avail timely treatment.

Psychological aspects of Fertility Treatments


At the onset, the dominant reason, but not the only one, for a majority of people who try fertility treatments is societal pressure. Seems like a simple statement, but, it is impregnated (pun intended) with an extremely complex and intrinsic web of various emotions. Every person is a unique being, a product of their unique genes and the environment they were brought up in. The effect of a variety of experiences through life, along with a profound effect of traumatic experiences (Trauma comprises of a lot of life events which include, but are not restricted to ,being subject to crimes, as generally assumed by society). To elaborate a little further, traumas survive in the body of a person, not just his/her/ others, mind.

So with the above introduction, we can safely assume that a patient getting treated for infertility is coming in, carrying all of his/her personality and experiences. Common psychological issues in such patients are, low self esteem, anxiety, and a sense of being subjected to prejudices. Many may also be suffering from severe anxiety as well as depression.

The mind and the body are interconnected, one invariably affects the other. Therefore, psychological counseling by trained psychological counselors for such patients would be highly beneficial not only for better treatment outcomes, but also in screening, which patients would first need to address psychological issues before beginning treatment. Therapy for all patients as part of the ongoing treatment cycles would definitely help the patient become more emotionally resilient and prepared to go through the medical procedures as well as have reasonable expectations. The gynaecologist may also be helped, by getting a more cooperative and prepared patient. A relatively relaxed patient is better than a tensed and anxious one. This is especially important in patients undergoing IVF, who should undergo counseling even before starting treatment. A few therapy sessions would go a long way in achieving emotional stability and a mindset more prepared to go through IVF cycles.

The role of a psychologist, especially trained to offer therapy to infertile couples is also vital in providing sexual counseling, pertaining to the treatment plan. The patients may also have developed a false, distorted view of oneself in terms of sexuality, given the stress associated with being infertile. Therapy provides such couples with a professional and safe environment to express their medical as well as emotional concerns, where they are met with empathy and empirical support.

Stress in general is known to cause physical ailments. Hence if doctors and psychologists could work together as a team, to help patients undergoing IVF/IUI and other fertility treatments, make informed choices, be reasonable and be as stress free as possible, we could conceive, (pun intended again!) a more promising future for successful fertility treatment outcomes.
