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

STIMULATION PROTOCOL FOR IUI WITH GONADOTROPIN

Always we have to see the baseline scan for any active CL, Antral follicle counts and ovarian vascularity.

For IUI:

Start with Tab Letrozole 2.5 mg on day 2-3 daily for 5 days followed by scan in day 7-9, for any dominant follicle i.e follicle of more than 10 mm mean size, if there is no dominant follicle we can wait for another 5 days, if dominant follicle is seen start with r-FSH 75 or FSH 150HP daily (never alternate day, also never use HMG in PCO as LH is already high in PCO and again HMG will cause increase in LH which is detrimental to the follicle) till you get a good endometrium triple line with grade 4 vascularity, you can give a trigger with gonadotropin same day followed by IUI 36 hour later or double IUI 24 and 48 hours if you think that follicle might get rupture early.

IF you didn't get a dominant follicle as in PCO you can start with a constant low dose protocol of FSH (r-FSH 37 IU and FSH-HP 75) daily till you get a dominant follicle, this protocol is for mono- follicular development for IUI, this may cost you more but u will get definitely a single follicle might have to wait for even 10 days after letrozole.

Key points:

- For age more than 35 you can use HMG instead of FSH other than that FSH is good option, as you can always get recombinant-FSH.
- Never use HMG in PCO due to high LH.
- Always wait for dominant follicle before starting gonadotropin for monofolliculardevelopment.
- Never use gonadotropin alternate day,(as terminal half-life of FSH is of 1 day) once started has to be used daily as pituitary is secreting daily FSH, so if you give FSH one day and stop on another the follicle will not get FSH by you and also the pituitary due to its down regulation by you, which will again deteriorate the follicle.
