

PAST PROGRAM REPORT

Role of Gynecologist as Preventive Oncologist

12.5% of all deaths are caused by cancer. It is more than the percentage of deaths caused by HIV/AIDS, tuberculosis, and malaria put together. It will be no.1 killer by 2010 in the world. Common gynecological cancers are cervical, ovarian, endometrial, vulval and gestational trophoblastic tumors.

Cervical cancer incidence is 27 / 100,000 women. 27% of worldwide incidence is in India. HPV infection accounts for 99% of all cervical cancers. Commonest high risk (oncogenic) HPV are 16,18 and low risk are 6,11 strains of HPV. For prevention of cancer cervix, the gynecologists can play vital role and are expected to do PAP smear of all patients. Recently introduced VIA and VILI (Visual inspection after Acetic acid or Lugol Iodine) are very easy, affordable, single visit, result oriented tests, requiring minimal infrastructure and are best suited for low economic areas .

HPV vaccine is available for prevention of cervical cancers. Quadrivalent (MSD) and Bivalent (Glaxo-Smithkline) types are recommended to be given to girls of 9-11 years of age with 3 doses at 0,2 and 6 months. It prevents 70-80 % of cervical cancers in addition to genital warts (quadri-valent). For early detection of cervical cancer one should do per speculum examination of cervix and followed by biopsy from any suspicious area. Precancerous lesions after proper exclusion of invasion could be treated with destructive or excisional procedures using cryotherapy, LEEP, electric cautery, CO2 laser or cold knife, or simple hysterectomy.

Carcinoma ovary presents silently with >90 % cases in advanced stages. It has high fatality ratio. Symptoms are nonspecific, mostly related to GI disturbances. It does not have precancerous stage like cancer cervix, thus to improve prognosis one aims to detect them in preclinical or early stages. Young women of >25 yrs age with familial ovarian syndrome are to be screened twice yearly for ovarian and breast cancer by sonography and mammography .These young girls should be advised oral contraceptives till family is completed and surgical salpingo-oopherectomy after completion of family. In post menopausal patients with adnexal mass serum CA-125 level is recommended. One can calculate

Risk of Malignancy Index (RMI), by scores of Years of menopause, Ultrasound score and CA-125 level. Cut off value for RMI is 200.

Carcinoma endometrium is the third commonest gynecological malignancy. Most patients are post menopausal. In all patients of perimenopausal or postmenopausal bleeding /discharge, fractional curettage should be performed prior to undertaking hysterectomy.

Gestational trophoblastic tumors are completely curable malignancies. While carcinoma vagina and vulva are uncommon. AOGS is thankful to team of GCRE, Dr. Pankaj Shah, Dr. Kalpanaben Dave, Dr. Mita Mankad, Dr. Pariseema Dave.

AOGS Medico legal Committee

Dear AOGS Members,

We are planning to develop a Medicolegal case Registry at our AOGS level.

We are in the process of making a form for the same. It will be circulated with next bulletin. Kindly fill the form and send it to the AOGS office. The purpose of the same is to gather records regarding which types of medicolegal problems are routinely faced by our colleagues and how they deal with it. Are they satisfied in the way there case is represented by their advocates and the ultimate result they get from the judiciary. We also want to know what our members expect from the AOGS society to do for them.

TIPS UNDER MTP ACT

Registration of Place:

- * MTPs can only be conducted in places that have been approved under the Act.
- * Application for approval of a place should be made in Form-A and must be addressed to the CDMO of the District.
- * The committee after recommendation of CDMO approve the place and grant a certificate of approval in Form-B.
- * Certificate of approval Form-B is to be displayed at conspicuous place in the premises.
- Co-operate during monitoring or inspection with the Authorities.

Requirements for obtaining MTP.

1. Indications 2. Woman's consent and 3. RMP(s) opinion.

Record Keeping

Records have to be maintained for all MTP procedures conducted by the unit.

- * Form-I- To record the opinion of the RMP conducting the MTP procedure.
- * Form-C- To record consent of the woman undergoing the MTP procedure. Consent of only the woman has to be obtained prior to conducting the MTP procedure. Spousal consent is not required. However in case of minor and mentally ill women, the consent of the guardian will have to be obtained.
- * Form-III- Is The Admission register for recording details of the MTPs conducted. Such register is to be kept for a period of FIVE years from the year it relates to.

The entries in the admission register are to be made serially, with a fresh serial no. to be started at the commencement of a new year from 1st January. Serial number of a particular year will be distinguished from the serial number of other years by mentioning the year against the serial number.

Admission register is a secret document and the informations contained therein is to be strictly confidential. It is to be kept in the custody of the head of the hospital or the owner of the Approved Place and is not open to inspection except under some special circumstances, such as -

(a) Woman applying for a certificate for obtaining leave.

(b) Under authority of Law.

No entries pertaining to the name of the pregnant woman can be made in Case-sheets, Operation theatre register, Follow-up card or any other document or register other than the Admission Register and all such references to the pregnant woman in such places other than the Admission Register is to be made by the Serial number assigned to the woman, and not by her name, in the Admission Register.

* Form-II- All forms are to be kept in the custody of the owner of the unit and a monthly statement of all the MTP cases have to be sent to the CDMO in form - II.

Custody of forms and reporting

The following documents are to be kept in a sealed envelope within three hours of doing MTP by the RMP who perform the MTP and kept in safe custody till the envelope is sent to the head of the hospital or the owner of the approved place or the CDMO of the State:-

- Consent given by a pregnant woman for the MTP i.e. Form-C,
- 2. Certified opinion of the RMP(s) i.e. Form-I and
 - Intimation of the MTP (every month)
 - Envelope should be marked "SECRET" should contain Serial number assigned to the pregnant woman in the Admission Register Name of the RMP(s) by whom pregnancy was terminated.

Reporting and record maintenance in situation of Emergencies

The address of the Approved Place or hospital and Date of termination of the pregnancy. Strict confidentiality has to be maintained for all records maintained under this Law. In the case of an MTP performed under section 5 of the Act, i.e., those necessary immediately to save the life of the woman, the columns pertaining to

- * The hospital or the approved place and
- * The serial number assigned to the pregnant woman, is to be left blank in form I

In such a case, the following details should be noted on the envelope marked "SECRET".

- * The name and address of the RMP by whom the MTP was carried out, and
- * Date on which it was carried out

If pregnancy is not terminated in an approved place or hospital, every envelope should be sent by registered post to the CDMO of the state on the same day on which the pregnancy was terminated or on the next working day following day on which the pregnancy was terminated.
