Past Programme Report









CME was organised on Sunday evening at St.Laurn by AOGS It was a successful programme with presence of around 100 delegates. Faculties were Dr. Hema Divakar from Banglore and Dr. Atul Munshi from Ahmedabad. Penalists were Dr. Manish Pandya from Surendranagar, Dr. Akshay from L.G. Hosp., Dr. Chirag Amin from Ahmedabad and Dr. Mahendra Soni from Himmatnagar. Dr. Hema spoke mainly on homocysteine, anemia in prenancy, and enlightened the audience about its clinical significance and gave practical tips. Dr. Atul Munshi covered myths and facts about calcium. He cleared many unknown things about calcium. Panel discussion was as usual very interesting. It was moderated by Dr. Hema, all the questions were well described and replied by panelists.

Carry Home message:

- 1. Homocysteine level should be less than 12; gives better pregnancy out come. Incidence of miscarriage, IUGR, PIH, congenital malformation reduces drastically.
- 2. IV iron sucrose-very safe, Best way to administer it as IV bolus-simple dilution of 2 amp (100 mg x 2) in 20 ml normal saline can be pushed in 10 minute every alternate day.
- 3. Simple calculation method 500 mg for storage plus 100 mg per gram of haemoglobin rise. By using this simple formula cost is reduced drastically. One of the panelist suggested to give it to all poor patient even immediately after delivery.


