
Volume 5 November 2008

KARNATAKA STATE CONSUMER DISPUTES REDRESSAL COMMISSION, BANGALORE

Complaint No. 33 of 2004 - Decided on 13.10.2006

(i) Consumer Protection Act, 1986 - Section 2(1)(g) Medical Negligence - Hysteroscopy - Absence of requisite facilities in hospital - Pulmonary embolism is known risk of hysteroscopy - Patient who gets pulmonary embolism needs to be put on ventilatior - OPs attempted to conduct hysteroscopy without having facilities to put patient on ventilator - Such negligence on part of OPs resulted in death of patient - Medical negligence proved - OPs liable to pay conpensation - Rs. 3,00,000 awarded. [pg. 337 (para 22)]

A patient, Manjula was advised to undergo Endoscopy Test at OP1 Nursing Home. She was informed that it was only routine test and not an operation and no risk was involved.

The OPs have contended that the patient had secondary Amenorrhoea and severe pain abdomen for 6 months following an abortion in another hospital and formation of intra-uterine infection and adhesion. When the patient did not have menstruation even after repeated courses of medicines, it was decided to do diagnostic hysteroscopy to find out the correct problem which procedure was completed in 10 minutes and after completion, the patient had a cardiac arrest due to pulmonary embolism. She was immediately revived by emergency resuscitation measures and she developed massive life threatening pulmonary oedema in spite of best efforts by Anaesthesiologist, operating surgeon, 2 senior Physicians, Gynaecologists and Hospital Staff to save the life of the patient. OPs have contended that when the condition of the patient was not improving, it was decided to shift her to Medical College Hospital at Davangere. Patient expired just before reaching the Medical College Hospital. OPs contend that everything was done in a most professional manner by the team of highly experienced doctors with the sole intention of saving the patient's life, which however, failed. They deny that there was any negligence on their part.

The death certificate, discharge summary issued by OP1 Hospital which shown the cause of death as "massive pulmonary oedema" due to pulmonary embolism.

The Other material evidence on record is the affidavit of Dr. Ramesh. B who claims to be Gynaecologist and Endoscopic Surgeon at Ramesh Hospital, Rajajinagar, Bangalore and claims to have had 10 years experience in Gynaecology & Endoscopic Surgeon. According to this witness, D and C would cause Asherman's Syndrome due to the adhesion of the walls of the uterine cavity. He says that hysteroscopy is one of the routine check-up to find out Asherman's Syndrome. He says that pulmonary embolism which may result in cardiac arrest is an interest risk of hysteroscopy and in such circumstance the patient requires to be put on ventilator.

OP2 in his evidence also says that pulmonary embolism is a well documented complication of hysteroscopy and in such case the patient needs ventilator.

OP2 and his own witness Dr. Ramesh say that pulmonary embolism is a known risk of hysteroscopy and when a patient who gets pulmonary embolism due to hysteroscopy needs to be put on ventilator. Admittedly, OP1 Hospital did not have the facility to put the patient on ventilator and that is why the patient was attempted to be shifted to Medical College Hospital at Davangere. Under thest circumstances, we feel that the attempt on the part of OP1 and 2 to conduct hysteroscopy without having facilities to put the patient on ventilator is a misadventure on the part of the OPs and that is a negligence on their part and that has resulted in the death of the patient. We, therefore, hold that OPs 1 and 2 are liable to pay compensation for deficiency of service.

Complainants have claimed compensation of Rs. 25.00 lakh. The complaint is allowed in part. OPs 1 and 2 are jointly and severally directed to pay to the complainants a global compensation of Rs. 3,00 lakh (Rupees three lakh.)

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
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
